2024-25 Large Grants Program – Fact Sheet

Funding

Grants of up to \$125,000 (plus GST) are available.

Eligibility

Organisations

Your organisation must be an incorporated, not-for-profit community organisation or a local government authority.

Projects

Projects must prevent or reduce gambling harm through activities that focus on:

- Harm prevention
- Early intervention
- Response

Projects must be delivered in Tasmania and benefit vulnerable Tasmanian groups and/or communities, such as those impacted by geographic, economic, health, social or cultural disadvantages.

Core or ongoing programs or activities will not be funded.

Costs to enhance or expand existing core or ongoing programs or activities will be considered.
